Day 1 - Travel to Tokyo, Japan

Day 2 - Tokyo, Japan

Welcome to Tokyo! Upon arrival your Funway Travel & Tours tour director will meet you at the airport and you will make your way over to your hotel. The rest of the evening is free to relax and prepare yourself for your Japanese adventure. (D)

Day 3 - Tokyo

Today you will discover Tokyo's must-see landmarks on the deluxe coach tour including a Matcha experience, admission to Skytree, and a Tokyo Bay ferry. Stroll the natural scenery at Meiji Shrine and drive past Akihabara, Ueno and other major attractions en route to the Imperial Palace. Then explore Asakusa with historical temples, shopping, matcha tea and Japanese Izakaya Lunch! In the afternoon, enjoy a 360-degree panoramic view from Tokyo Sky Tree and relax on a Tokyo Bay Cruise.

Itinerary

This evening, you will discover the history, training and rules behind the typical sumo match and watch real clashes between wrestlers while you enjoy a meal of Chanko Nabe (hotpot). (B, L, D)

Day 4 - Tokyo - Hakone

This morning is free to explore, shop, and dine in Tokyo before boarding the train for a quick ride to Kamakura. After checking into the hotel, you will begin to explore the Hakone region at your own pace. With the two-day Hakone pass, you will have access to unlimited travel on the local trains, buses, sightseeing cruises, and ropeways (cable cars).

While in the Hakone region you will be able to explore nature, cultural activities indoors and out such as museums, shrines, and the Great Buddha. View of Mount Fuji, the national park, and the lakes are available from the ropeway (cable car) and pirate ships! (B, D)

Day 5 - Hakone - Kyoto

This morning you take part in a traditional Supreme Sencha - a

tea ceremony. Sencha-do is a tea ceremony that does not use powdered green tea. In sencha-do, tea is carefully brewed by infusing green tea leaves. In this workshop, you will first observe the tea ceremony to understand the atmosphere and its culture. After observing the ceremony, you can actually use a tea utensil to brew tea! Late afternoon you will ride the rails to Odawara and connect to the Shinkansen, Japan's bullet train. Relax and enjoy the Japanese countryside as you travel at speeds up to 199 miles-per-hour en route to Kyoto. (B, D)

Day 6 - Kyoto

Today you discover lots of Kyoto's dispersed temples, shrines, and cultural attractions with a local, English speaking tour guide. Your tour of Kyoto will begin with Kiyomizu temple, one of the World Heritage sites. After visiting the temple and taking in the panoramic views of Kyoto from Higashiyama hill, you move on to Sanju-sangen-do Temple to discover the fantastic statues in the main hall. Following a morning of temple discovery, we will stop for a lunch break in Arashiyama. Enjoy a Jap-

anese buffet along with a superb view from your seat overlooking the Togetsukyo Bridge. Immediately following lunch, we will go through the Bamboo Forest to Tenryu-ji temple.

You will visit the Tenryu-ji temple, also listed as one of Kyoto's World Heritage Sites. Here you will see a traditional Japanese garden that was designed and has remained unchanged for more than 700 years. From here, you move on to Kinkan-ji temple where you will see The Golden Pavilion covered with pure gold leaves. This is the symbol of Kyoto. Your tour of Kyoto wraps up as you make your way past Nijo Castle to Fushimi Inari Shrine, the most popular place in Kyoto. Here you will go through one of the One thousand Torii gates, and unforgettable experience. The inari shires host the guardian gods for business success, well-being of family, and performing arts!

After dinner, the evening is yours free to explore more of Kyoto. Pop over to the world



headquarters of Nintendo for a photo opportunity! (Admission to Nintendo building is not allowed.) (B, L, D)

Day 7 - Kyoto - Osaka

Today is at your own pace. Group leaders will be allowed time for morning group activities in Kyoto before traveling by rail to Osaka. The afternoon and evening schedules are left to your group leaders to give a personal touch to your Japanese adventure. (B, D)

Day 8 - Osaka

Today you get a taste of local life in Osaka with a walking tour of Japan's third largest city. Witness Osaka's different faces, from bustling business center to historic cultural hub, as you follow your local, English-speaking guide, through the city's vibrant neighborhoods. Stroll along the lively waterfront of the Dotonbori entertainment district; visit the landmark Hozenji temple; and ride the subway like a local.

You will see the iconic symbol of Osaka - Osaka Castle which

played an important role in the unification of Japan during the samurai era of the sixteenth century. Next you stroll through Shinsal-bashi-suji Shopping Street; a covered, 600-meter-long street which has been Osaka's most important shopping area for 400 years with hundreds of shops. Your tour of Osaka continues with stops at Ebisu Bridge, Dotonbori Tsurubori, Hozenji Yokochō, Hozen-ji Temple, Kuromon Market, Sennichimae Dog Yasuji Shipping Street, Nipponbashi Denden and Shinsekai. Following your tour of Osaka, the rest of the day is yours free to explore and shop. Revisit some of the great shopping streets to search for that perfect souvenir. (B, D)

Day 9 - Hiroshima

This morning you will take a comprehensive full day tour to Hiroshima. Start with a ride on the super-speed bullet train from Osaka to Hiroshima. Once you arrive you will then board a boat to the idyllic Miyajima Island, home to the splendid Itsukushima Shrine. This is one of Japan's finest shrines famous for its beautiful Shiden-zukuri style structure. After your visit, you will return to Hiroshima

for a stop at the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum. This large-scale park was established in 1949 after the Pacific War ended and is visited by countless visitors as a symbol of peace. The museum withing the park is an Important Cultural Property of Japan and was built to remind future generations of the terror wrought by atomic bombs. Next you will pass by the Atomic Bombe Dome, a symbol of the disastrous atomic bombing during WWII and the first atomic bombs used in human history. This area has been preserved to promote peace and elimination of atomic weapons around the world.

Tonight, we will join for a farewell dinner and say good-bye to the Land of the Rising sun. (B, D)

Day 10 - Return the USA

Your journey home begins after breakfast this morning with a transfer to the airport in Osaka. (B)
